READING EXIT SLIPS

This pack can be used all year round and in a variety of ways and settings. Use these exit slips:

These exit slips are differentiated in that all of the DRA comprehension concepts are covered, but some slips allow for illustration rather than words, while others require writing. This way, you can choose the slip based on the abilities of your students.
