OPEN ME WHEN...

With little prep for you (only making copies!), students can create a thoughtful gift set for their parents for **any special occasion!** Students will create a set of envelopes titled “Open Me When _____” and design/complete the prompts for each envelope. **Thoughtful messages and activities** are enclosed in the envelopes and meant to be opened throughout the year by the gift receiver—it is truly **the gift that keeps on giving!**

Design a recipe the child can make with the adult for some special quality time!

This envelope contains a blank note for the adult to write to the child as a surprise!

Adult and child fill out their own surveys and also guess surveys for the other person. Then, they check answers!
