
How does this work?

With little prep for you (only making copies!), students can create a thoughtful gift set for their parents for any special occasion! Students will create a set of envelopes titled "Open Me When and design/complete the prompts for each envelope. Thoughtful messages and activities are enclosed in the envelopes and meant to be opened throughout the year by the gift receiver—it is truly the gift that keeps on giving!







Design a recipe the child can make with the adult for some special quality time!




This envelope contains a blank note for the adult to write to the child as a surprise!




Adult and child fill out their own surveys and also guess surveys for the other person.


Then, they check answers!

Kids trace their hands and connect them by string so the adult can have a "hug" when he opens the envelope!




Kids will decorate a personalized scrapbook page to reminisce about good times the child has had with her parent/adult.






Scavenger hunt comes in 3 formats with varying difficulty

In this envelope, adults will get a mini-book about them (My mom likes to ______, My mom does NOT like to ______, I love the way my mom _______, etc.)


This envelope also contains an introductory letter to the adult explaining the nature of this gift!
